### **RING ONE: Eventer Challenge (sponsor tbc)**

One round over a mixture of show jumps and cross-country type obstacles in a grass arena.

CLASS 1: 60cm      CLASS 2: 70cm      CLASS 3: 80cm  
CLASS 4: 90cm      CLASS 5: 100cm

**PRIZES:** Huge rosettes 1st to 10th in each class, plus Highest Placed MHRC member. 1st Prize: tbc  
**ENTRY:** MHRC Members: £15 per class      Non-Members: £20 per class



### **RING TWO: Style Jumping (sponsored by NAF)**

Riders salute to the judge, then canter a figure of 8 (change of leg can be through trot) before commencing their round. Each jump is marked on rider's ability to present horse at the fence correctly. Please visit our website for more information, hints and tips!

**RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- All classes will be run under current British Riding Club rules.** A copy can be found on our website and will be displayed on the showground.
- The committee reserve the right to cancel, amend or alter the order of events.
- The committee reserve the right to refuse entry or disqualify any animal that is deemed unfit to compete.
- The committee and landowners will not be responsible for any injuries arising from accidents to persons or animals, or theft of properties on the grounds during the event.
- The Judges and the Committee's decision shall be final on all matters during the event.
- Any objections are to be handed to the Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £20 to be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
- This showground is kindly lent to us; the show is run entirely by volunteers. Anyone using unreasonable behaviour, bad language, dropping litter, mucking out on the showground, mistreating any animal or anything else that affect the Club's reputation, will be asked to leave the showground.
- All horses and ponies must be at least 4 years old to compete.
- All dogs must be kept on leads at all times; failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the showground. Please clear up after your dog.
- The road outside the showground is very busy. It is the responsibility of everyone to ensure the gates remain closed after entering or leaving the showground.
- Stallions are eligible to compete at this show, but all BRC rules apply and stallion discs must be worn on both sides of the bridle. Please inform the secretary when picking up your number.
- Refunds will be given before the closing date on production of a vet or doctors certificate. After the closing date, they will only be given if the space can be filled by a reserve competitor.
- Non-BRC competitors must be covered by current public liability insurance.
- All horses must be vaccinated for flu and have received a booster within the last 12 months.

**EVENTER CHALLENGE**

- Hard hats** and **Body Protectors** are compulsory at all times when mounted. Both **MUST** comply with the current BRC guidelines.

- Horses/Ponies can only compete in a maximum of **2** classes.
- All riders must report to the steward, correctly attired and wearing their number, before they will be allowed in the warm-up arena.
- Jackets or Cross-country colours may be worn.

**STYLE JUMPING**

- Hard hats** are compulsory at all times when mounted and **MUST** comply with the current BRC guidelines.
- Jackets and correct dress must be worn, but may be relaxed at the judge's discretion if warranted by the weather.

**LEGAL LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence or the organisers, or for anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Riding Club, nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their content and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

**HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE:** The Organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards. Additionally, those attending this event must report incidents or accidents to the Secretary involving Property or Vehicle Damage, Personal Injury or Personal Illness.
